Coating Preparation Technician

Description: Prepare optics for coating production per work order and schedule. Clean and inspect parts and perform QA and incoming inspection.

Job Functions/Requirements/Responsibilities:

Primary job functions are listed below but may change without notice.

- Pre-cleaning delicate optical lenses carefully.
- Keep track of serial number on optics and record accordingly for coating preparation.
- Inspect, final wipe, and load optics for coating production per schedule.
- Other duties may be assigned.

- Ability to manage time wisely in order to meet deadlines.
- Demonstrate attention to detail.
- Must be independent worker, self-motivated.
- Ability to handle and grasp small lenses with hands.
- Must possess a positive attitude, including the ability to quickly adapt to changes in production requirements.
- Able to effectively communicate verbally and in writing.
- Proficient at using Microsoft Word, Excel, Outlook, PowerPoint, and the internet.
- Frequently required to sit and use hands/fingers to feel
- Occasionally required to reach with hands and arms, walk, stand, talk, and hear.
