



## Coating Technician I

**Description:** Manufacture thin film coating by operating coating chamber per work order and schedule. Clean and inspect parts and QA and capable of checking the coating performance by using spectrophotometer. Maintain/clean coating chamber per schedule.

### Job Functions/Requirements/Responsibilities:

Primary job functions are listed below but may change without notice.

- Responsible for operating and maintaining vacuum coating chamber.
- Cleaning optics and loading/unloading and inspecting and packaging optics in a timely manner.
- Keep records of coating runs and maintenance logs.
- Utilize spectrophotometer to check coating performance and make report.
- Assist engineering in all aspects.
- Final lens inspection for quality assurance
- Other duties may be assigned.

### Knowledge, Abilities, & Skills Required:

- Ability to manage time wisely in order to meet deadlines.
- Demonstrate attention to detail.
- Must be independent worker, self-motivated.
- Must possess a positive attitude, including the ability to quickly adapt to changes in production requirements.
- Proficient at using Microsoft Word, Excel, Outlook, PowerPoint, and the internet.
- Frequently required to sit and use hands/fingers to feel, and reach with hands and arms.
- Occasional walking, standing, talking, and hearing.
