Clean and inspect parts and QA and capable of checking the coating performance by using spectrophotometer. Maintain/clean coating chamber per schedule. Overview ongoing production and assist the bottleneck in production flow.

### Job Functions/Requirements/Responsibilities:

Primary job functions are listed below but may change without notice.

- Supervise assigned shift coating production team.
- Work with other Coating Technician II to maintain schedule and team morale for both shifts.
- Responsible for training new employees placed on respective shift.
- Enforce all policies and guidelines.
- Follow-through and maintain schedule on a daily basis.
- Develop and improve processes within department, work with employees to achieve.
- Enforce team-building by demonstrating in daily operations.
- Responsible for operating and maintaining vacuum coating chambers.
- Cleaning optics and loading/unloading and inspecting and packaging optics in a timely manner.
- Keep records of coating runs and maintenance logs.
- Utilize spectrophotometer to check coating performance and make report.
- Assist engineering in all aspects.
- Troubleshoot and repair all coating equipment in a timely manner.
- Assist technician to make job flow smoothly.
- Continually working to improve processes, products, and procedures.
- Other duties may be assigned.
